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Parent Survey Findings

A survey of Clintondale Community Schools elementary, middle, and high school parents was conducted during the period December 14-22 by Banach, Banach & Cassidy (BB&C), a Michigan-based marketing and survey research firm.

The purpose of the online survey was to assess parent opinions about virtual and in-person learning and to provide parent feedback for consideration by the Clintondale Community Schools Board of Education as Board members consider instructional options for 2021.

The survey was completed by 303 parents of elementary school students, 122 parents of middle school students, and 127 parents of high school students.

Snapshot Summary of Findings

The bottom line

The bottom line is that—given a choice between virtual and in-person learning in 2021—parents of students at all three grade levels say they would prefer in-person learning.

Parents were asked this question at the conclusion of the survey:

COVID-19 conditions permitting, by late January the school district may be able to offer both in-person learning and virtual learning options. If that is the case, which option would you select for your child?

Here are the parent responses by grade level:

While parents at all grade levels say they would prefer in-person learning, 23 percent of high school parents, 32 percent of elementary parents, and 36 percent of middle school parents say they would choose a virtual learning option in 2021. It is

also important to note that a significant number of parents at each grade level are “not sure at this time” whether they would select an in-person or virtual learning option.

It seems plausible that the number of parents opting for virtual learning in 2021 would increase if some of the concerns about virtual instruction are addressed by the school district.

Difficulties with virtual learning

Most Clintondale students started the school year taking virtual classes. This was the case for 59 percent of high school students, 60 percent of elementary students, and 61 percent of middle school students.

At all levels, more than one-half of parents responding to the survey said that their child had difficulty adjusting to virtual learning. Difficulty adjusting was reported by 54 percent of high school parents, 56 percent of middle school parents, and 57 percent of elementary parents.

When asked to describe any difficulties their child experienced, parents provided 270 responses to the question (148 at the elementary level, 63 at the middle school level, and 59 at the high school level). Each response is reported in the complete list of survey responses that appear later in this report. Readers of this report will find some common themes in the responses. For example, most elementary parents reported that their children had difficulty staying focused, experienced computer or connection problems, and missed connections with their friends and teachers.

At the middle school level, parents said that their children had difficulty logging in to virtual classes, staying focused on their lessons, and experienced Internet and Zoom issues.

High school parents said that their children had difficulty logging in, paying attention and maintaining focus, and keeping up with their lessons.

Parent problems with virtual learning

When asked what problems virtual learning posed to parents, respondents provided 412 responses (227 at the elementary level, 95 at the middle school level,

and 90 at the high school level]. All 412 responses appear later in this report and are summarized here:

Elementary level parents reported the most problems. The list included difficulties balancing work and helping/supervising their child, helping students stay focused, and childcare issues. Many elementary parents expressed frustration simultaneously dealing with parents and work responsibilities, and difficulties with monitoring their children and helping them with lessons.

Middle school parents said that they found virtual learning frustrating for themselves and their children. Many said that they found it difficult to support their child, keeping their child on task, and monitoring lessons and academic progress.

At the high school level, parents reported having difficulty with Internet connection issues, monitoring their child's learning, and keeping their child focused. Secondary parents also expressed a need for more teacher to parent communication.

The detailed responses to all questions provide valuable insight, especially, in this case, to understanding the unique problems faced by parents. These range from dealing with five children at home learning virtually to limited access to technology and the Internet to the frustrations parents have helping their children learn.

Additional support the school district can provide

Parents were asked what additional support the school district could provide to help their child with virtual learning. Again, the detailed responses to the summary below appear later in this report.

At the elementary level, many parents said that the school district was "doing the best it can." Others expressed a need for more in-person instruction and more tutoring and help for students who were struggling academically.

Middle school parents also asked for more tutoring and help with struggling students. They also suggested more teacher-student interaction and more teacher to parent communication.

High school parents suggested more hands-on learning experiences, more teacher to parent communication, and more online tutoring.

Improving communication

While most parents said they are satisfied with the communication they are receiving from their child's teacher (elementary 93%, middle school 72%, high school 51%), parents at all grade levels had suggestions for improving communication.

At the elementary level, parents want more telephone and online support, better instructions regarding lessons, and more information on their child's progress.

Middle school parents asked for more frequent progress reporting, email updates on lessons and progress, and calls from teachers when their child is experiencing learning problems.

High school parents suggested more email messages regarding lessons and learning problems, more progress monitoring, and more teacher-parent contacts.

Levels of satisfaction

Seventy percent of elementary parents, 66 percent of middle school parents, and 53 percent of high school parents said that they were generally satisfied with the academic progress their child was making this year.

Those who said they were not satisfied were asked why they were not satisfied with the academic progress of their child. The detailed responses that appear later in this report can be summarized as follows:

Elementary Parents:

- experiencing difficulty with virtual learning
- difficulty keeping their child focused on lessons/learning
- lack of academic progress with virtual learning
- need more personal contact between students and peers/teachers

Middle School Parents:

- need help getting children to focus
- need more in-person learning

experiencing difficulty with technical aspects of virtual learning

High School Parents:

experiencing difficulty with technical aspects of virtual learning

need more interaction with other students and teachers

prefer in-person instruction



Q1 Did your elementary child start the school year taking virtual classes?







Q1 Did your middle school student start the school year taking virtual classes?





Q1 Did your high school student start the school year taking virtual classes?


